

Panoply Vase Animation Project Privacy and Cookie Policy

We respect your privacy and want you to be informed about the ways we protect, use and share the information that we collect when you visit our website, www.panoply.org.uk, and when you email us directly.

This Policy applies to personal information that you provide to us through the use of our website, and when you contact us directly. If you have any questions about this Policy please contact us at panoplyvases@gmail.com.

The information we collect is minimal:

1. When you contact us directly by email, Twitter or Facebook message, we hold any personal information you choose to give us in the strictest of confidences and only use and store them for the purposes of providing a service to you and future contact with you. We will not use your information to target you for marketing purposes.

All information is held digitally on password controlled devices that are fire-walled and virus checked regularly.

Should it be necessary to share any of your information or transfer it to hard copy for the purposes of our work your explicit permission shall be sought first in each case, and the hard copy will be shredded when it's finished with.

2. Our website is hosted on the *Cambridge School Classics Project's* web platform. We have no control of, or maintain any cookies that might be used on the CSCP platform.

A cookie is a small text file that a website saves on your computer or mobile device when you visit the site. It enables the website to remember your actions and preferences (such as login, language, font size and other display preferences) over a period of time, so you don't have to keep re-entering them whenever you come back to the site or browse from one page to another. The cookies may take personal details, such as your IP address or information about which particular web browser you are using.
